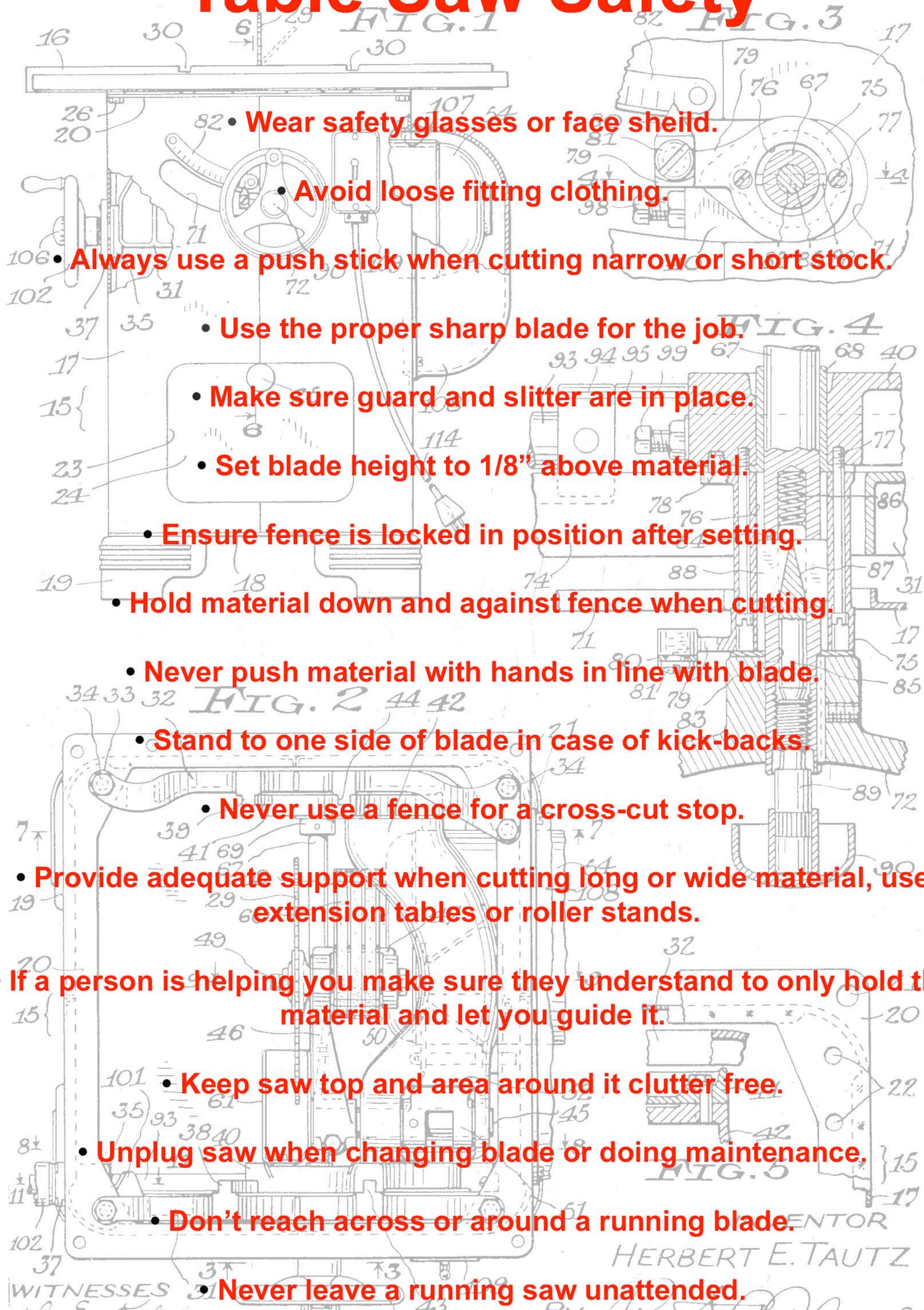


# Table Saw Safety



- Wear safety glasses or face shield.
- Avoid loose fitting clothing.
- Always use a push stick when cutting narrow or short stock.
- Use the proper sharp blade for the job.
- Make sure guard and splitter are in place.
- Set blade height to 1/8" above material.
- Ensure fence is locked in position after setting.
- Hold material down and against fence when cutting.
- Never push material with hands in line with blade.
- Stand to one side of blade in case of kick-backs.
- Never use a fence for a cross-cut stop.
- Provide adequate support when cutting long or wide material, use extension tables or roller stands.
- If a person is helping you make sure they understand to only hold the material and let you guide it.
- Keep saw top and area around it clutter free.
- Unplug saw when changing blade or doing maintenance.
- Don't reach across or around a running blade.
- Never leave a running saw unattended.
